Within the last few months, Jemez Mountains Electric Cooperative, Inc. has experienced an increase in vandalism to the Co-op's distribution and transmission infrastructure. Power poles and other substation components have been subjected to copper theft.

We would like to ask the public that if you see or suspect any type of suspicious activity in or around JMEC Co-op power lines or substations, immediately report it to law enforcement or call the Co-operative at (505) 753-2105.

It is important to emphasize that extreme high voltage is present at all areas of distribution/transmission power lines including substation equipment. Serious injury (death) could result in trespass and unauthorized contact with JMEC equipment not to mention increased maintenance costs for repairs which are passed on to our members.
