

MEMBERS' COMMENTS/SUGGESTION HIGHLIGHTS

2011 ANNUAL MEETING – JULY 17, 2011

516 members registered, needed 1068 for a quorum

48 comments/suggestions submitted

- 14 out of 48 stated they wanted term limits set for elected officials (Board of Trustees).
- 9 out of 48 stated the location/facility/parking was not suitable for this meeting.
- 4 out of 48 stated that they would like the rates to either be lowered or not increased.
- 3 out of 48 stated they want the Cooperative to get more and better quality door prizes (not just for the adults, but also for the children).
- 3 out of 48 stated they would prefer the Cooperative to spend and/or SAVE money in other ways rather than purchasing seat cushions or printing green membership slips that were never used.
- 1 out of 48 stated they wanted to reduce the number of board member seats.
- 1 out of 48 stated they wanted to see the Board of Trustees to fully support the General Manager and his delegation in expediting negotiations.
- 1 out of 48 stated they wanted their Board of Trustees to be more concerned, interested and committed to their constituents.
- 1 out of 48 stated the Cooperative should seek grant money to conduct solar experiments in one community (i.e. Dixon) and see how it works. If the results are good, then proceed with other communities.
- 1 out of 48 stated they would like the Cooperative to encourage membership for donations to assist the disabled/sick or people who are having trouble paying their bills so electricity shut-off will not be an added burden.
- 1 out of 48 stated to change out ALL meters to automatic meter readings.
- 1 out of 48 stated they wanted the Cooperative to be better about payment arrangements.
- 1 out of 48 stated they thought the \$25.00 service fee for warning notices was ridiculous (**JMEC HAS FILED A NEW DISCONNECTION FEE WITH THE PRC TO REDUCE THE FEE FROM \$25 DOWN TO \$15**)
- 1 out of 48 stated the Cooperative should change: 1 meter = 1 vote.
- 1 out of 48 stated they would like to see a place where cans, paper and plastics can be recycled during annual meetings.
- 1 out of 48 stated they wanted better sound system so they could hear the speakers.
- 1 out of 48 stated they wanted more flavor in the food.
- 1 out of 48 stated 'power surges'.
- 1 out of 48 wanted better coordination for the annual meeting.
