SPECIAL MEETING

TUESDAY, DECEMBER 15, 2020

1. This meeting of the Jemez Mountains Electric Cooperative, Inc. Board of Trustees was called to order by Chairman Leo Marquez at 10:00 a.m. on the above-cited date, at JMEC Headquarters, 19365 S.R. 84/285, Hernandez, NM.

This meeting was conducted in accordance with the Public Health Emergency Order issued by the State of New Mexico.

2. & 3. Following the Pledge of Allegiance, Nick Naranjo, Secretary, called roll and confirmed the presence of a quorum.

4. APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA

ACTION: Upon motion by Mr. Cordova and second by Mr. Naranjo, the agenda was approved as published.

5. ELECTION OF OFFICERS

Chair Marquez thanked the Board for granting him the honor of serving as chairman. He then opened the floor for nominations.

Chairman

Mr. Vigil nominated Dennis Trujillo for Chairman. Mr. Duran seconded.

There were no other nominations and Mr. Vigil moved to close nominations and elect <u>Dennis Trujillo Chairman</u> by acclamation. Mr. Naranjo seconded and that motion passed without opposition.

Mr. Marquez invited newly elected President Dennis Trujillo to chair the remainder of the meeting.

Chair Trujillo thanked Mr. Marquez for his service and welcomed Ms. Maestas-Muller to the Board.

Vice Chairman

Ms. McCoy nominated Bruce Duran to serve as Vice Chairman and Mr. Naranjo seconded the nomination.

There were no other nominations. Mr. Vigil moved to close nominations and by acclamation declare <u>Bruce Duran Vice Chairman</u>. Mr. Naranjo seconded and the motion passed without opposition.

Secretary

Mr. Crawford nominated John Ramon Vigil to serve as Secretary. Ms. Maestas-Muller seconded the nomination.

There were no other nominations and Mr. Duran moved to close nominations and by acclamation declare <u>John Ramon Vigil Secretary</u>. Mr. Naranjo seconded and that motion passed without opposition.

Treasurer

Ms. Maestas-Muller nominated Dolores McCoy to serve as Treasurer. Mr. Naranjo seconded.

There were no other nominations and Mr. Vigil moved to close nominations and by acclamation declare <u>Dolores McCoy Treasurer</u>. Mr. Naranjo seconded and the motion passed without opposition.

Asst. Secretary/Treasurer

Mr. Vigil nominated Stanley Crawford and Mr. Duran seconded the nomination. There were no further nominations and Mr. Duran moved to elect <u>Stanley Crawford Asst. Secretary/Treasurer</u> by acclamation. Mr. Naranjo seconded and the motion passed without opposition.

Chair Trujillo appointed Lucas Cordova to continue to serve as JMEC's Tri-State representative.

6. NEW BUSINESS

Chair Trujillo requested staff provide him a listing of standing and ad hoc committees and he would be making new appointments by January.

Mr. Marquez advised the new chair that legal counsel was involved in negotiations with the tribes. He offered his full assistance in all matters to the new chair.

Chair Trujillo said it was his desire that Trustees work as a united front for the good of the Co-op.

Mr. Crawford acknowledged the graciousness of the outgoing officers during this election process noting that the Trustees are all working for the benefit of the Co-op.

General Manager Gonzales said he would not abandon the Co-op and was here to assist in the transition to a new general manager. He understood his services may be required for an additional period and emphasized that, he was ready to retire from the industry.

Manager Gonzales pointed out that the budget will be presented in six month increments for timelier Covid-related reporting.

Mr. Crawford requested that future agendas include an open dialogue/session for Trustees to share ideas about improving the Co-op.

Upon motion by Mr. Cordova and second by Mr. Crawford, Chair Trujillo adjourned the meeting at 1922 (20).
